Cattle MUST carry a NLIS tag and be Tattooed
The age of the Cattle is at the date of the show
All calves at foot must be under 9 months on day of show. Calves at Foot must be eligible for registration in the Breed Society of the Dam

The Chief Steward reserves the right to withdraw an entry at their discretion.

All Bulls over 12 mths of age must be led by a ring through the nose, bulls 9-12 mths by a nose grip.

No bull 2 yrs and over to be led by person under 18 yrs of age.

Horned animals and bulls are not allowed in the Junior Parader's competition

All beef females over 9 months must be led with a nose grip.

All cattle are to be tethered by a halter and also secured by a neck strap.

Cattle must be supervised by the owner/handler at all times.

The National Animal Herd statement for johnes disease status must be returned with entry form otherwise entry forms will not be accepted.

No Clipping chutes are to be erected on show day.

Smoking is not permitted in the cattle area.
